

How to make the Polyglots puppets

Paper puppets

1. Print the puppet template onto A4 paper.
2. Place the printed page on top of another piece of A4 paper.
3. Cut along the solid line of the puppet template.
4. Staple along the dotted line.

Alternatively, you can cut out the puppet image and paste it onto a paper bag.



Cloth puppets

1. Purchase iron-on transfer paper. This is available from Officeworks, Spotlight, Lincraft, Arthouse Direct and other craft supply shops.
2. Print the image onto the transfer paper using an inkjet printer or copier.
3. Iron the printed images onto fabric. Fabrics such as cotton drill, calico or broadcloth work best.
4. Cut along the solid line.
5. Lay the piece of fabric with the printed image face down on another piece of the fabric.
6. Sew along the dotted line or a 1-cm seam allowance. Turn and press. Hem the open edge if desired.
