
Chatterbox





Cut out your chatterbox.



Turn it face down then fold and unfold on both diagonals.



Fold all four corners to the centre.



Turn over. Fold all four corners to the centre.

Fold in half vertically. Unfold.



Fold in half horizontally.



Slide your thumb and index finger into the four slits to move your chatterbox.

Chatterbox

Preparing your chatterbox

- On your chatterbox template, write the words for cat, dog, rabbit and horse in your chosen language under the animals in the outer corners.
- Write the colour words for orange, grey, brown, pink, green, blue, red and yellow in your chosen language on the corresponding coloured triangles.
- Colour in the larger animals in your choice of colour.
- Write the colour word and animal word in the space underneath each animal that you coloured in, for example, 'blue cat'.
- Now your chatterbox is ready for folding (see folding instructions below the chatterbox template).

Script for language play

- Ask a partner to choose an animal and tell you in your chosen language.
- Spell out the letters for the animal word in your chosen language, moving the chatterbox with each letter.
- Ask your partner to choose a colour and tell you in your chosen language.
- Spell out the letters for the colour in your chosen language, moving the chatterbox with each letter.
- Repeat.
- Ask your partner to choose a colour and lift the flap of that colour.
- Ask your partner to guess the animal by saying a full sentence in your chosen language, for example, 'Is it a pink dog?'
- Respond in a full sentence, for example, 'No, it's a blue rabbit.'
