Happy birthday poster

The Happy birthday poster can be used to celebrate the birthdays of the children in your class.

Here are some ideas for using the poster:

For the wall

- 1. Print and cut out the candles on this page.
- 2. Print the poster in A3 or A4, and cut out, laminate and display it in your learning space.
- 3. When it is one of the children's birthdays, use a whiteboard marker to write their name on the cake.
- 4. Attach the correct number of candles to the cake.
- 5. The child, or all the children together, can count the candles in your chosen language.
- 6. Practise saying 'Happy birthday' in your chosen language to the birthday child throughout the day.

As a take-home poster/card/certificate

- 1. Print the poster.
- 2. The child can cut out and paste on, or draw on, the correct number of candles for their age.
- 3. Encourage the child to count the candles in your chosen language.
- 4. The child can write their name on the cake.
- 5. The birthday child can take home the poster to share with their family.

Note: With some families, you may need to be mindful of any cultural sensitivities around the celebration of their child's birthday.
